Actions Speaks Better Than Words

"By this all men will know that you are my disciples if you love one another."

(John 13:35)

Speaking words is a clear language, but actions can have more profound effect than words. The following is an account of a man who came to know Jesus Christ not through words but through actions.

He is a man of 32 years old age; he was successful in his medical field, he had finished almost all his life time in studying medicine and devoted himself fully to work in that field. But inspite of such great devotion and success in study and in his profession he was not living a joyful life. He has no satisfaction. Although he had much but he was not enjoying what he was bless with. He had many plans but there is no hope and no future in anyone of them.

Exactly at this time of his life where he was empty from inside, lack of contentment and loaded with frustrations, he was invited to a Christmas dinner by a small group of believers in Jesus Christ. He was happy to go to that Christmas party because he missed the atmosphere of the family, the delicious food and the love and care of others. Since he enjoyed that fellowship of the believers he went out frequently with them in their out door fellowship and he was attracted with the followings: -

1) They love one another: Truly there was a genuine love among them. They care for each other; they help those who are weak and those in need. Although they were of different nations and they speak different languages, but they love one another as if they are one family. If some one is missing they remember him and look for him. If some one has a problem it is their problem, if some one is sick all are concern about him. And if someone receives a victory or success the whole group rejoicing and happy because they consider themselves one family.

Through the true and genuine love that he receive from this group of believers he experienced the love of God who sent His son Jesus Christ to the world, who died for our sins on the cross and rose from the dead to give eternal life to those who believe in Him. In return he started to show others the true love of God that he receive from his master.
