***In all labour there is profit; All

4- Those who speak much will

things that they need to do. They

*will loss opportunities to do their
basic needs of the day.*

be recognized, other time they are
not easy to be discovered especially
when they will speak nice words,
flatters, or attractive stories. You
need to be discerning to avoid such

put you in troubles.*
