

Evil and bitter for you when you forsake the LORD

“19 Your wickedness will punish you; your backsliding will rebuke you. Consider then and realize how evil and bitter it is for you when you forsake the LORD your God and have no awe of me,” declares the Lord, the LORD Almighty. 20 “Long ago you broke off your yoke and tore off your bonds; you said, ‘I will not serve you!’ Indeed, on every high hill and under every spreading tree you lay down as a prostitute. 21 I had planted you like a choice vine of sound and reliable stock. How then did you turn against me into a corrupt, wild vine?”

(Jeremiah 2:19-21 KJV)

When people sin against God and do wicked things in their lives, the first impression about them will be, the Lord shall punish them. That is true and sure God will do something to deal with the wickedness of his people.

Amazingly **Jeremiah 2:19** disclose to us important way that God is using to punish his wicked people, those who left him, and as the following:

Your wickedness will punish you; God had established certain system

Your backsliding will rebuke you. God had made it clear that those who move away from God, and backslide from following Him, their backsliding will be used as a source to rebuke them.

Consider then and realize how evil and bitter it is for you when you forsake the LORD your God and have no awe of me: The Lord followed such a way of system so each and every person who do wrong will ultimately realize that his own wrong doing is the source of his misery. That is will be beneficial in leading people toward repentance.

Long ago you broke off your yoke and tore off your bonds; you said, ‘I will not serve you!’ Those who broke their covenant and went away from God they thought it is smartness not to serve God.

Indeed, on every high hill and under every spreading tree you lay down as a prostitute. They behave smarter when they went, serving and prostituting themselves with other things, thinking that serving God is a waste or foolishness.

God has good thoughts toward His people and good plans for them; this what God would say to those who became corrupt and practiced wickedness against him, **“I had planted you like a choice vine of sound and reliable stock. How then did you turn against me into a corrupt, wild vine?”** Therefore when they will become corrupt and wicked then surely the corrupt vine shall turn to be a misery for their lives.

As you read the message, then repent from your sins and once again commit yourself to God as you agree to pray.
