FAITHFULNESS

"Let love and faithfulness never leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart." (Proverbs 3: 3)

Since the creation of the heaven and earth, the plants, animals and finally the man, the Lord was loving and faithful to the things that he created. - 5. *Faithfulness to the society:* This includes the area that we are living, we should observe the rules and system, and help to build the society in the right way. We should act as a good examples for other to give them the model that they should follow. We should be faithful to our employer, where we are working; doing our job precisely and honestly whether the eyes on us or not. Faithfulness also to the city where we living, keeping order, laws and preserving the structure. Faithfulness shall extend to our country and nation. We are responsible to take care of our country and nation to build it in the right way.

My dear and beloved: Faithfulness may be the character of certain people but it is a spirit of God that build in us commitment, accountability and responsibility. Faithfulness is to remember your promises and vows that your gave and that you need to fulfill.
