

Fear God!

“28 He sent darkness, and made it dark; and they rebelled not against his word.” (Psalm 105:28 KJV)

Moses and Aaron observed their orders, in performing them just as God appointed them, and they rebelled not against His Word **28 He sent darkness, and made it dark; and they rebelled not against his word.** Moses and Aaron did not rebel as Jonah did, who, when he was sent to denounce God’s judgments against Nineveh, went to Tarshish.

Moses and Aaron were not moved, either with a foolish fear of Pharaoh’s wrath or a foolish pity of Egypt’s misery, to relax or retard any of the plagues which God ordered them to inflict on the Egyptians, but stretched forth their hand to inflict them as God appointed.

Those that are instructed to execute judgment against sinners and against wicked people, when they will relax and will not do, this action of them will be considered rebelliousness against God’s and against His word.

The plagues of Egypt that He asked Moses and Aaron to do are here called God’s signs, and his

wonders, “**27 They performed his signs among them, his wonders in the land of Ham.” (Psalm 105:27)** They were not only proofs of God’s power, but tokens of His wrath, and to be looked upon with admiration and holy awe.

Moses and Aaron showed the words of His signs for every plague that God had sent to inflict punishment on Pharaoh and his official who resisted God.

The plague of darkness, this was one of the last. God sent darkness, and Moses and Aaron did not question God about this plague and the rest of the plagues because they believe that God knows what He is doing.

Moses and Aaron did not sympathized with the Egyptians and did not yield to their naïve human emotions.

Many who are called by God to implement certain commands they fail to do them because they are yield to their feelings and emotion. Many they do not rebuke and discipline their children because they pity them, but that is considered rebelliousness against God, because He is the one who placed the children under the

parents and He is the one who commanded the parents to discipline their children.

There is good number of people who entertain and keep and protect criminal people just because they pity them or they don’t believe that they deserve as such.

Those who are using their own understanding to analyze certain situations and who put aside the implementation of God’s commands and judgment, they are unaware that they are taking the place of God in managing the affairs of life, and that is consider rebelliousness.

My prayer that this message of God’s Word will be imparting to you the fear of God that will lead you to repentance, and to renew your mind to start to think in conformity to God’s law and Word as you agree to pray.
