

Fully Trusting the Lord

(Part 1)

“¹ To you, O LORD, I lift up my soul; ² in you I trust, O my God. Do not let me be put to shame, nor let my enemies triumph over me. ³ No one whose hope is in you will ever be put to shame, but they will be put to shame who are treacherous without excuse. ⁴ Show me your ways, O LORD, teach me your paths; ⁵ guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and my hope is in you all day long. ⁶ Remember, O LORD, your great mercy and love, for they are from of old. ⁷ Remember not the sins of my youth and my rebellious ways; according to your love remember me, for you are good, O LORD. ⁸ Good and upright is the LORD; therefore he instructs sinners in his ways. ⁹ He guides the humble in what is right and teaches them his way. ¹⁰ All the ways of the LORD are loving and faithful for those who keep the demands of his covenant. ¹¹ For the sake of your name, O LORD, forgive my iniquity, though it is great. ¹² Who, then, is the man that fears the LORD? He will instruct him in the way chosen for him. ¹³ He will spend his days in prosperity, and his descendants will inherit the land. ¹⁴ The LORD confides in those who fear him; he makes his covenant known to them. ¹⁵ My eyes are ever on the LORD, for only he will release my feet from the snare. ¹⁶ Turn to me and be gracious to me, for I am lonely and afflicted. ¹⁷ The troubles of my heart have multiplied; free me from my anguish. ¹⁸ Look upon my affliction and my distress and take away all my sins. ¹⁹ See how my enemies have increased and how fiercely they hate me! ²⁰ Guard my life and rescue me; let me not be put to shame, for I take refuge in you. ²¹ May integrity and uprightness protect me, because my hope is in you. ²² Redeem Israel, O God, from all their troubles!” (Psalm 25:1-22)

God is great, He is our banner and He is our strength. We might be in hardship, we might be squeezed in the corner, pressed from every side, persecuted and trials had knocked us down but we still have the hope in the Lord. King David had this hope, and me and you are the same.

To you, O LORD, I lift up my soul: The soul is the center of feelings, emotions and decision making. The soul is also the part of man that determined for destiny; the wicked soul will be end up in hell and forever, but the righteous soul will be end up with the Lord in heaven and forever. to follow His Word and commands they will never be put to shame. ***But they will be put to shame who are treacherous without excuse.*** Sometimes we see evil doers who had gone beyond limit because of certain privilege they have like they belong to certain race, bearer of certain ethnic identity, holder of position, or have education that might protect them. That may help them for a while, but finally, sooner or later, as long as they did not put their hope, faith and trust in God and live in a treacherous way of life they will be put to shame. That should be clear to us, that there is no other way that we can live a good life and got saved with out being in the Lord and in obedience to His Word and commands. Therefore, for this purpose, make up your mind clear and come to the Lord and ask from Him the following:-

Show me your ways, O LORD, teach me your paths; guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and my hope is in you all day long. Be assured that if you are in any trouble or difficult situation there is a way that God can take you out from it and be saved. Jesus said in *John 14:6* ***“I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.”*** Jesus is the only way to reach God the Father in heaven, and He is the only way for us to come out from out problems. Jesus is the way out from the valley that you are in. He is the way to go out from the trouble that you are in now. Ask Him to teach you His path and take you out from the dilemma that you are in. Ask Him to guide you out and give Him your hand and ask Him to lead you in the safe way. He is just a prayer away. Trust Him, pray and ask Him, then you will find yourself in the full truth. Jesus would reveal to you the full truth and you will be saved and delivered from whatever trap that you are in. Cry to Him and pray, ***‘Remember, O LORD, your great mercy and love, for they are from of old.’*** God had helped others and saved them, and He is willing to help us today. Lord had helped you in the past and He is willing to help you today.
