

God Is Pressed Under You!

"Therefore saith the Lord, the LORD of hosts, the mighty One of Israel, Ah, I will ease me of mine adversaries, and avenge me of mine enemies:"

(Isaiah 1:24 KJV)

"Behold, I am pressed under you, as a cart is pressed that is full of sheaves."

(Amos. 2:13 KJV)

1- Promoting immoralities, "How is the faithful city become an harlot!"

honored. Divorce and remarriage all are now approved by the church.

2- No more justice, "it was full of judgment; righteousness lodged in it;" But now no more. Those who do wrong no one is questioning them or correcting them. But today the church and the church leaders are against those who are fighting against sin; those who oppose sin are now persecuted by the church.

3- Murders, "but now murderers." Evil doers are protected and those who do evil are preserved and promoted so in return they are doing more evil.

4- Corruption, "Thy silver is become dross,"

5- Cheating and diluting the commands of God, "thy wine mixed with water:" Taste and quality is lost. The Holy Spirit work now is mixed with the flesh.

6- Church leaders they don't obey the commands of God, "Thy princes are rebellious." They fear man, they respect person and not God.

7- They are after financial gains, "companions of thieves:"

9- They don't address and apply solutions for real problems, "they judge not the fatherless, neither doth the cause of the widow come unto them." They are busy and spend much money on seminars and conferences but the real problems of the church are kept aside.

"25 And I will turn my hand upon thee, and purely purge away thy dross, and take away all thy tin: 26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city." (Isaiah 1:25-26 KJV)

A- God will allow heavy trials to shake His church in order to be cleansed from corruption, "25 And I will turn my hand upon thee, and purely purge away thy dross, and take away all thy tin."

B- God would remove the corrupted leaders and put righteous people instead of them, "26 And I will restore thy judges as at the first, and thy counsellors as at the beginning: afterward thou shalt be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city." This God would do in a painful way in order to deal with a corrupted church and their leaders to replace them with leaders and with people who fear God.

It is the end time. It is a terrible time. As we are waiting for Jesus to come and take us, let us take heed of the message and repent and do the things that we ought to do.
