## He Who Watches Over You!

"I lift up my eyes to the hill - where does my help come from? My help comes from the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth. He will not let your foot slip – He who watches over you will not slumber; indeed, He who watches over you will neither slumber nor sleep.
