The Great Mission

One day, my neighbor knocked at my door and ushered a man whom he said had been looking for me. I let the person in, and we had a wonderful time talking about old friends and previous experiences. We shared a table of food and drink and had a happy fellowship. The time went on and as my visitor proposed for the visit to end, we hugged and said goodbye to each other. But while he was at the door shaking my hand, my visitor told me to do one thing. His last words to me were kept in my mind and in my heart; I meditated on what I last heard him saying. Finally I said to myself, "Yes, I will do." I have to do what he asked me. It is as important as his visit to me to accomplish what he commanded me to do.

The Lord of glory, the Creator of heaven and earth, our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ came from heaven. He became man and made his dwelling among us to bring back the mankind to God. Men sinned against God and their sins separated them away from God; but God who is generous in love and mercy made a way for all mankind to come back to God and have new relationship with Him; "For God so loved the world that He gave His One and Only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16)

Jesus came to save sinners from death. We are sinful, "But God demonstrates His won love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8) "For the Son of Man came to seek and save what was lost." (Luke 19:10) Jesus lived with his disciples and followers. He taught them many things about the Kingdom of Heaven until Jesus dies on the cross paying the price of the people's sins. He was buried but He rose again from the dead. Through the eleven who first carried out the mission to go and make disciples, many believed in Jesus and accepted Him as Saviour and He became Lord over their lives. They entered the Kingdom OF God and they received the assurance of having eternal life. But what made the eleven and those who heard them obey the command to go, preach, and teach, others about the Lord Jesus?

1- Salvation is found in no-one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to man by which we must be saved." (Acts 4:12) There is no other name but the name of Jesus who said, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No-one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:8) Jesus Christ is the only Saviour who can save us from eternal punishment of death and hell. He is
