The Mouth and the Hand of God

"10 A divine sentence is in the lips of the king: his mouth transgresseth not in judgment." (Proverbs 16:10 KJV)

"10 The lips of a king speak as an oracle, and his mouth does not betray justice." (<u>Proverbs 16:10</u> NIV)

Judges, magistrates and kings are supposed to be the mouth of God on earth to execute judgment and the justice of God.

God had placed them on earth to do His needful work in regard to justice and to help the oppressed and those who are week and has no power to go against the strong that are oppressing them; for that is the command of God and the commission of God for them to do, "3 Defend the poor and fatherless: do justice to the afflicted and needy. 4 Deliver the poor and needy: rid them out of the hand of the wicked." (Psalm 82:3-4 KJV)

God had placed them in the right places to do that particular job of justice, and He had given them authority that extending from Him. God even said about them, "6 I have said, Ye are gods; and all of you are children of the most High." (Psalm 82:6 KJV) God had given them and ordained to them all these privileges to do all that needful tasks. A divine sentence is in the lips of the king: As they know the rules of the nations they should execute justice, and in this way their decision is the divine sentence of God that He is speaking and executing through them.

10 The lips of a king speak as an oracle: Those in authority when they decide, their decision would represent the will of God. Therefore their decision will be like a vision or a revelation declaring the whole will of God.

His mouth transgresseth not in judgment: In their decision they should be fair and just and treating the weak and the poor the same as they treat the rich and the strong. They will not sin by siding and be bias with one party against the other.

And his mouth does not betray justice: The judges, the magistrates and the kings who transgress against the law, this mischief will be considered a betrayal to the trust and the authority that they have received from God.

Everyone should know this: "1 God standeth in the congregation of the mighty; he judgeth among the gods." (Psalm 82:1 KJV) God is there in every court of judgment to rule and to moderate that His will be done.

And He, sooner or later, will rebuke and deal with those who judge unjustly, "2 How long will ye judge unjustly, and accept the persons of the wicked? Selah." (Psalm 82:2 KJV)

Those who are in position but they will not do well in keeping justice and judgment as God ordain they are bringing the earth out of the ordained course, "5 They know not, neither will they understand; they walk on in darkness: all the foundations of the earth are out of course." (Psalm 82:5 KJV) Therefore for this reason God will ultimately deal with those wicked judges, magistrates and kings and bring them out of the scene, bringing even death upon them, "7 But ye shall die like men, and fall like one of the princes." (Psalm 82:7 KJV)
