

The Way To Be Blessed

(Part 7)

“Blessed is the man you discipline, O LORD, the man you teach from your law.” (Psalm 94:12)

God’s love is so abundant and His grace and His blessings are to those who fear Him and walk in His ways. God’s blessing is there to us and we can receive that only through His ways. The Lord would bless us when He disciplines us and corrects us so that as we go in His ways then His blessings will flow in our lives.

Blessed are those who have learned to acclaim you, who walk in the light of your presence, O LORD.” (Psalm 89:15) Those are the people who come to know the way of the Lord and as they maintain His ways and laws in their lives His blessings will continue to flow in their lives. They will keep doing what is right and just and therefore they are claiming and receiving God’s blessings.

“Blessed are they who maintain justice, who constantly do what is right.” (Psalm 106: 3) Many people they will say, ‘Why we don’t have God’s blessing and why we are not receiving from Him? He cheated his brother Esau and stole from him his birth right and the blessings of the first born. Jacob thought that such way of life will bring blessings in His life. God had seen all that behavior and the Lord disciplined Jacob and gave him hard time in his life in order for him to realize that he cannot rely on himself and need to

obey God and follow God’s commands and rely fully on and be patient until the Lord would come and bless him. The Lord also will do the same with you. If you are going ahead of God and you think that you can attain it with your own strength and resources then you are in error and wait for troubles in your life. If you would not listen God sure will allow certain troubles and trial in your as He allowed it in Jacob’s life to make you realize and see your real small size and your nil resources in compare to God’s power and resources. Jesus said the following: ***“You are in error because you do not know the Scriptures or the power of God.” (Matthew 22:29)*** You ought to read the scripture, correct yourself and follow carefully what God’s said in His word. God will not change Himself or His word, therefore don’t resist and allow him to change you

“³²Now then, my sons, listen to me; blessed are those who keep my ways. ³³Listen to my instruction and be wise; do not ignore it. ³⁴Blessed is the man who listens to me, watching daily at my doors, waiting at my doorway. ³⁵For whoever finds me finds life and receives favor from the LORD. ³⁶But whoever fails to find me harms himself; all who hate me love death.” (Proverbs 8:32-36) This is then the clear message. Blessed are those who keep the ways of the Lord. Wise are those who listen to God’s instruction and do not ignore it. Blessed are those who obey God. Favour and life for those who finds God. Harm to those who fail to find God. Those who do not listen and obey God they hate Him and in this way they are harming themselves.

“Whoever gives heed to instruction prospers, and blessed is he who trusts in the LORD.” (Proverbs 16:20) God’s instruction is the tactful thing of God and will bring dramatic and crucial changes in your life. Prosperity will come in your life when you listen and follow these instructions.

“Blessed is the man who always fears the LORD, but he who hardens his heart falls into trouble.” (Proverbs 28:14) It is blessedness if you keep fearing God and obeying him.
