“20 My son, keep thy father's commandment, and forsake not the law of thy mother: 21 Bind them continually upon thine heart, and tie them about thy neck. 22 When thou goest, it shall lead thee; when thou sleepest, it shall keep thee; and when thou awakest, it shall talk with thee.”

(Proverbs 6:20-22 KJV)

“20 My son, keep your father's command and do not forsake your mother's teaching. 21 Bind them always on your heart; fasten them around your neck. 22 When you walk, they will guide you; when you sleep, they will watch over you; when you awake, they will speak to you.”

(Proverbs 6:20-22 NIV)

Solomon was instructed by his father, David, to go along the Word of God and to abide in its decrees. The same for us today as we read this proverb and read the word, 'My son,' then we can consider that God the Father is speaking to us and asking us to do the following with the Word of God that we receive from Him.

1- Keep the Word of God: Abide in what it says to you. Keep her so it will keep you.

2- Forsake not: Nothing can help you in this life except God's Word; therefore you should not leave it.

3- Bind them and tie them: Do not let the Word of God be away from you. Bind them on your heart and tie them around your neck.

Keep reading, meditating and obeying the Word of God. When that will be your attitude toward the Word of God then the following is what you will reap:

A- When you walk, they will guide you and lead you: Many times you find people they don't know where to go and what to do because they have no intimacy with the Word of God. That is why you need to keep the Word of God close to you so it will lead you and guide you.

B- When you sleep, they will keep you and watch over you: When you keep and obey the Word of God, the command that you obeyed will be a source of protection to you. The Word of God that you obey will watch over all the affair of your life and it will extend the protection and the care even to the hidden areas that you do not see.

C- When you awake, they will speak and talk to you: The Word of God that you had hide in your heart will start to talk to you, and will

give you the commands with timely instruction to let you do what you need to do.

Take heed of the message and value the Word of God for the great benefits that you are going to receive as you agree to pray.
