

What Can Satisfy God?

“21 I hate, I despise your feast days, and I will not smell in your solemn assemblies. 22 Though ye offer me burnt offerings and your meat offerings, I will not accept them: neither will I regard the peace offerings of your fat beasts. 23 Take thou away from me the noise of thy songs; for I will not hear the melody of thy viols. 24 But let judgment run down as waters, and righteousness as a mighty stream. 25 Have ye offered unto me sacrifices and offerings in the wilderness forty years, O house of Israel? 26 But ye have borne the tabernacle of your Moloch and Chiun your images, the star of your god, which ye made to yourselves. 27 Therefore will I cause you to go into captivity beyond Damascus, saith the LORD, whose name is The God of hosts.” (Amos 5:21-27 KJV)

What can make God satisfied?

1- Feasts, celebrations, conferences and seminars? This what God will answer, **21 I hate, I despise your feast days, and I will not smell in your solemn assemblies.** Feasts and assemblies cannot compensate failures to deal with real issues that have not yet been faced by the church and properly addressed.

2- Tithes and Offerings? This what God will answer, **22 Though ye offer me burnt offerings and your meat offerings, I will not accept them: neither will I regard the peace offerings of your fat beasts.** Giving of

all kinds cannot please God while sins and wrong practices are still observed by the church workers and members. Giving might be used to support wrong practices and projects that are not of God's will. Giving might be used to please leaders and get positions and privileges. Giving is needed but to be loyal to God and His will and His word should come first. Giving cannot replace the latter.

3- Music, singing, praise and worship? This what God will answer, **23 Take thou away from me the noise of thy songs; for I will not hear the melody of thy viols.** Music has direct influence on the heart and can make it feels well. But what the use of the feelings if sin and spiritual sicknesses are still there?

Music can make people feels good but will not solve problems, that is why God is saying **Take thou away from me the noise of thy songs; for I will not hear the melody of thy viols.** Your music can be played on the people feelings but will not please the living God where sin and corruption is going on.

Sound mixture to beatify music will not please God, **24 But let judgment run down as waters, and righteousness as a mighty stream.** Judgment and taking Godly decisions, and allowing the ordinances of God and His laws to be prevailed in the life of the people,

that what the church needs today and that what will please God.

25 Have ye offered unto me sacrifices and offerings in the wilderness forty years, O house of Israel? God is telling, that giving will not be acceptable with this wrong doing: **26 But ye have borne the tabernacle of your Moloch and Chiun your images, the star of your god, which ye made to yourselves.** What you carry of non-biblical principles and wrong priorities and practices are similar to the idols worship and the life style of pagan.

People of God should carry the principles of God's Word, but now they are carrying on their shoulders all the worldly councils. Bible should not put aside and worldly solution to be adopted. That what make God grieved.

Listen now, 'Feasts, giving and music in church context and activities cannot please God if your life had not been changed radically to follow God.'

God cannot be mocked and He is able to deal with His church and people, **27 Therefore will I cause you to go into captivity beyond Damascus, saith the LORD, whose name is The God of hosts.** Such kind of complacency in the life of the church and keeping sin and perpetuate it with feast and music and supported with giving, is a sin, and God sure will judge it on His right time and way.
