## What Heaven Can Do?

"23 Though he had commanded the clouds from above, and opened the doors of heaven, 24 And had rained down manna upon them to eat, and had given them of the corn of heaven. 25 Man did eat angels' food: he sent them meat to the full." (Psalm 78:23-25)

God had given His people undeniable proofs of His presence with them and His power upon them, not only on earth beneath, but in heaven above when He rained manna and corn on them.

He had commanded the clouds from above, and opened the doors of heaven: When God created the cloud was in order to send showers to the earth to reproduce harvest of various crops, and food for man and animals. But now God commanded them not to shower down rain but corn and manna themselves, which is therefore called here the corn of heaven; 24 And had rained down manna upon them to eat, and had given them of the corn of heaven.

25 Man did eat angels' food: he sent them meat to the full. With what God did with them He proved to them and to us today the followings:-

*1- That heaven can do the work without the earth.* 

2- Earth cannot do the work or exist without heaven.

3- God took it ill when they distrust Him after He had been so very kind to them that He had rained down manna upon them to eat. The food He sent them was substantial food, daily, duly, enough for all, enough for each and fir for all the ages. God will judge us fairly if we will distrust Him after He had shown us mercy and had given us all our needs.

4- Man did eat angels' food; God gave His people the food of angel and He delivered it to them by the ministry of angels: the food descended from the dwelling of angels. Every one of them, even the least child in Israel, did eat the bread of the mighty; the weakest stomach could digest it, and it was so nourishing that it was strong meat for strong men and made them fit for the battle. And the provision was so good, yet it never reduced to short allowance; for He sent them meat to the full. If they would gathered little, it was their own fault; and even yet they had no lack, "18 And when they did mete it with an omer, he that gathered much had nothing over, and he that gathered little had no lack; they gathered every man according to his eating." (Exodus 16:18) The daily provision God made for us since we came into the world, has so

much of miracle as this, and is full of God's mercy, therefore we need to value whatever we receive from God and let whatever we receive from God make our faith to increase and our fear and reverence to increase toward Him.

5- Heaven can rain other things when there is need: Heaven not only rained manna and corn, but also flesh, "26 He caused an east wind to blow in the heaven: and by his power he brought in the south wind. 27 He rained flesh also upon them as dust, and feathered fowls like as the sand of the sea: 28 And he let it fall in the midst of their camp, round about their habitations. 29 So they did eat, and were well filled: for he gave them their own desire;" (Psalm 78:26-29) To all that by faith and prayer ask, seek, and knock, these doors shall at any time be opened; for the God of heaven is rich in mercy to all that call upon Him. He not only keeps a good house, but keeps open house.

Let the message makes you more oriented about heaven in regard to salvation, deliverance, miracles, and whatever other needs still you look up toward heaven and pray in faith and fear and reverence toward God who can rain on you and supply all your needs.
