The ways of the world is to gain wealth and riches, high position, prestige and honor to have pleasure. The people of this world believe that if you achieve the better you are, the more you gain the more you enjoy. The world does not believe or give account to humbleness or meekness. Instead, daily it emphasis self-confidence and pride. The person who is humble and meek is weak and he is to be neglected. The world does not believe in patience and waiting upon God. The message that we should learn from Lazarus and the rich man is not to live as poor or sick and to reject riches, but to live a life that goes with God's way.
