you will not experience with Jesus because His words are true, perfect and never changed.

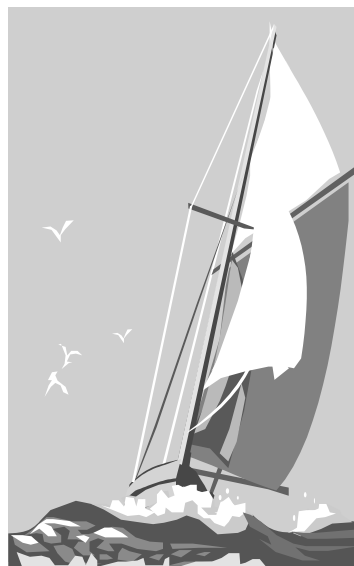

MY PRAYER

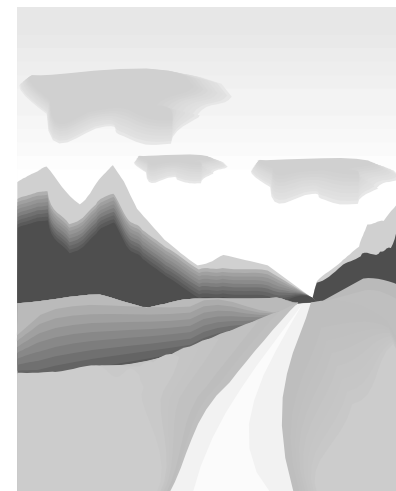
