1- Are you is sitting in your place of work asking a question and urgently needing an answer?

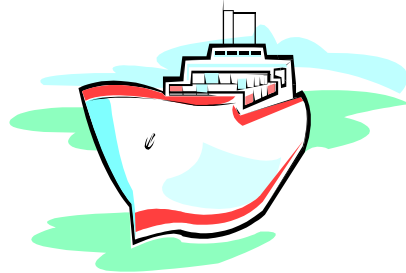
2- Are you sitting on your chair pondering on many different thoughts and ideas but you don't know where to start?

4- Are you at the crossroad and need to choose one sure direction to walk on to succeed?

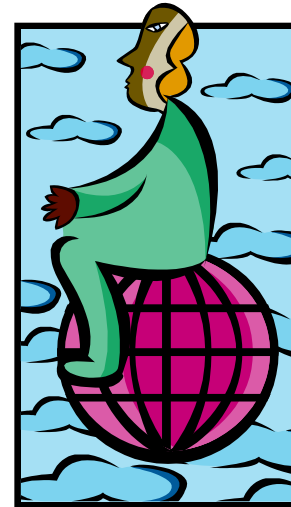
Therefore, this verse from the Bible is a personal message for you from Jesus Christ.
