"When such a person hears the words of this oath, he invokes a blessing on himself and therefore thinks, "I will be safe, even though I persist in going my own way." This will bring disaster on the watered land as well as the dry.²⁰

The LORD will never be willing to forgive him; his wrath and zeal will burn against that man. All the curses written in this book will fall upon him, and the LORD will blot out his name from under heaven. ²¹ The LORD will single him out from all the tribes of Israel for disaster, according to all the curses of the covenant written in this Book of the Law." (Deuteronomy 29:19-21)



The word of God teaches us good and practical things that we can apply in our lives. It helps us to remove the deception of Satan from our minds.

Some Christians they boast and brag that they are long years in the Lord, but they forget one important thing; Christianity is not how many years you are in the faith but how much you obey God and walk in His ways.
