

“¹ Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. ² Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. ³ For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. ⁴ When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.”

1- Set your hearts on things above: What you love must and what is your heart desire that is one of the most important thing for God. What you love most? Is the Lord, His word and His will, or there is something else in your heart you love more than God? This important question you need to answer correctly to God.

2- Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things: What is in your mind, what you are thinking and what you are planning for? In this aspect God also wants you to be accountable to Him.

What is in the mind of man is essential for the next decision and the next step that he is going to take in his life.

Two important organs in man, his heart and his mind; both these two places God also work to bring full repentance and fruit in man’s life.

If you keep your heart and your mind for God and set both of them on the things that God think and God love then when Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.
