*Peoples go and run after material things to collect and gather but are not looking forward to what is ahead of them, the life after death. <sup>10</sup>For all can see that wise men die; the foolish and the senseless alike perish and leave their wealth to others. <sup>11</sup>Their tombs will remain their houses forever, their dwellings for endless generations, though they had named lands after themselves. <sup>12</sup>But man, despite his riches, does not endure; he is like the beasts*

*that perish. <sup>13</sup>This is the fate of those who trust in themselves, and of their followers, who approve their sayings. <sup>14</sup>Like sheep they are destined for the grave, and death will feed on them. The upright will rule over them in the morning; their forms will decay in the grave, far from their princely mansions.”*(Psalm49:10-14)

*Do not be mislead and be like others who run after perishable and worldly things. God had given you understanding so that you will not be enticed to do the same and loss the eternal life that God had given to you. <sup>16</sup>Do not be overawed when a man grows rich, when the splendor of his house increases; <sup>17</sup>for he will take nothing with him when he dies, his splendor will not descend with him. <sup>18</sup>Though while he lived he counted himself blessed—and men praise you when you prosper—<sup>19</sup>he will join the generation of his fathers, who will never see the light of life.”*
