but I love your law.”**
(Psalm 119:113)

What is meant by the double-minded men?
Let us search the Scripture that will tell us
the meaning.

1- **“I hate double-minded men, but I love your law.”** (Psalm 119:113) From this Scripture the meaning of double-minded men most likely are those who does not love the word of and who does not walk according to the truth we have in the word of God. Because the writer of Psalm 119:113 differentiate himself from them by being loving and abiding to the Law of God.

And if the double-minded men hate the law of God then they are living in evil ways and stand with the sinners in how they conduct their lives affairs.

Another Scripture that contained the word double-minded is James 1:5-8, **“If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him. ⁶But when he asks, he must believe and not doubt, because he who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. ⁷That man should not think he will receive anything from the Lord; ⁸he is a double-minded man, unstable in all he does.”** From the above Scripture the double-minded man characterized as the following:-

2- A man without wisdom.

3- A man with doubts.

4- A man who is shaky tossed here and there and he cannot decide and stand firm because he has no foundation that based on the word of God.

5- A man who is without faith on God and on His word.

6- A man who is not receiving anything from the Lord.

7- He is unstable and you cannot depend on him at all. He is undependable person.

Another Scripture that contained the word double-minded is James 4:8, **“Come near to God and he will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.”** From the above Scripture the double-minded man characterized as the following:-

8- He is a man far away from God.

9- There is a way for him that God would come near to him by repentance and turn from sin.

10- He can repent by stop doing evil things. Repentance will give him the faith on the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ who will show him His good plan for him. Repentance will give him the faith on the word of God and on His promises that will teach him how to live his life to please God.

11- He needs to be sanctified in order that his heart would be clean, so that his life would be pleasant to the Lord who will find him a noble vessel to be filled with the Holy Spirit.
