

¹ Praise the LORD. Praise God in his sanctuary; praise him in his mighty heavens. ² Praise him for his acts of power; praise him for his surpassing greatness.”

(Psalm 150:1-2)

Praising God is to proclaim loudly what the great things that He had done for us and to His people.

Praising God involves the following:

1- Praise Him from the inmost being, as in Psalm 103:1 “Praise the LORD, O my soul; all my inmost being, praise his holy name.”

2- Singing praises unto him as in Psalm 135:3 “Praise the LORD, for the LORD is good; sing praise to his name, for that is pleasant.”

3- Lifting up the hands as in Psalm 134:1-2 “Praise the LORD, all you servants of the LORD who minister by night in the house of the LORD. Lift up your hands in the sanctuary and praise the LORD.”

4- Bowing down as in Psalm 138:1-2 “I will praise you, O LORD, with all my heart; before the “gods” I will sing your praise. I will bow down toward your holy temple and will praise your name for your love and your faithfulness, for you have exalted above all things your name and your word.”

5- Shout aloud as in Psalm 81:1 “Sing for joy to God our strength; shout aloud to the God of Jacob!”

6- Clapping of hands as in Psalm 47:1 “Clap your hands, all you nations; shout to God with cries of joy.”

7- Dancing as Psalm 150:4a “Praise him with tambourine and dancing.”

8- With musical instruments as in Psalm 150:3-5 “³ Praise him with the sounding of the trumpet, praise him with the harp and lyre, ⁴ praise him with tambourine and dancing, praise him with the strings and flute, ⁵ praise him with the clash of cymbals, praise him with resounding cymbals.”
