Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD and shun evil,
this will bring the following into your life:

A- Health to your body:
Sin can bring sickness in life? Yes, therefore be careful to obey God so healing will flow in your body. You will have peace of mind and rest round about.

B- Nourishment to your bones:
You will have the strength that you will receive from the Lord to go on and live your life unto Him in doing his will.

Obedient life unto God will bring good health in our lives.
