5- It spares you evil: ***“Through love and faithfulness sin is atoned for; through the fear of the LORD a man avoids evil.”*** (Proverbs 16:6)

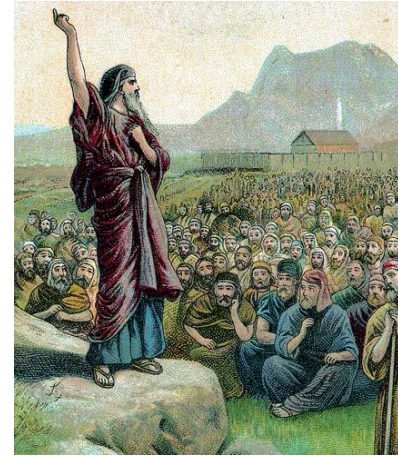
6- ***“Humility and the fear of the LORD bring wealth and honor and life.”*** (Proverbs 22:4)
