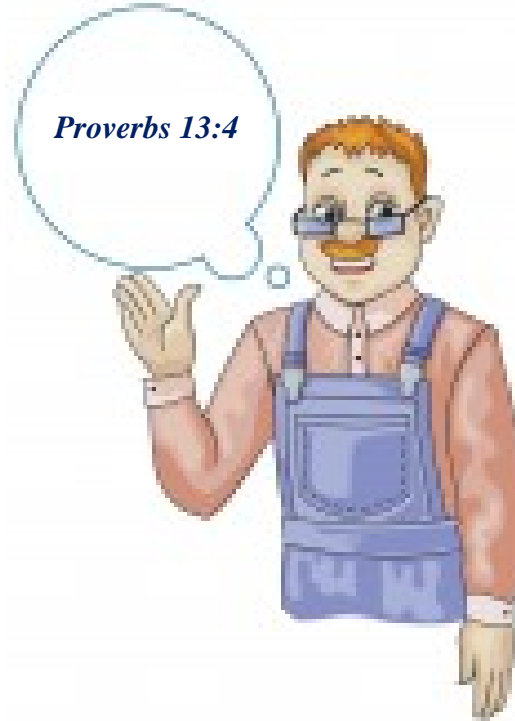
Appetite and hunger if not satisfied it is a painful desire. But that pain that God allow man to feel will help him to improve, got a vision, progress and go forward.

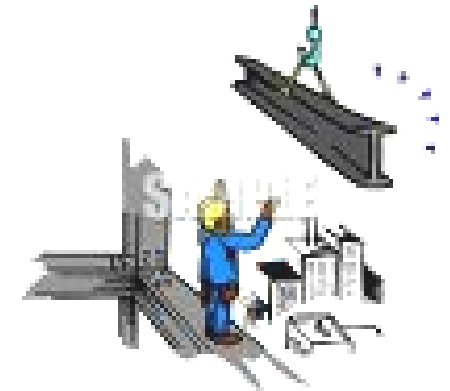
