(Ecclesiastes 10:1)

Therefore guard yourself and be aware of your thoughts, talks and actions. Because folly, can be initiated in the mind, and then will be manifested in talks and deeds.

A little leaven of folly can vitiate a whole lump of wisdom, and a single fool can undo the work of many wise men.

Further, folly is more immediately evident. It will be easily recognized; it proclaims itself on the street.

Some people they disobey rules so they will be recognized and become famous. That is another way folly manifesting itself. Therefore be aware not to do that

because that will not bring good to you but only harm.

If you had been walking wisely for a good period of your life, but then you had committed a folly that almost outweighed all the good that you had achieved, then you need to repent and come back to God. Acknowledge what you had done wrong, asking Him to restore you and bring you back to the original plan that He had for you.

Let this message be also a warning to every one of us who walk in wisdom and understanding that we will continue to do that and not giving way for even a little folly to enter and destroy our lives and all the good things that we had achieved.
