

“²⁶ Do not be a man who strikes hands in pledge or puts up security for debts; ²⁷ if you lack the means to pay, your very bed will be snatched from under you.”

(Proverbs 22:26-27)

The bible warns us clearly about not to go in debts by borrowing money. As well as the bible warns us not to go for pledge by putting our belongings (Jewels, gold, house, etc) in guaranty of what we borrow.

So how then you will pay what you had taken and free yourself from the pledge?

*If you lack the means to pay, your very bed will be snatched from under you: That is the truth and there is no compromise in it. Some people they go into borrowing and go doing their own will and plans thinking that God will provide for them to pay that pledge money. **Do not be the man** who does such thing. Don't throw yourself and think that God will send His angel to carry you. God will not do that, **“Do not put the Lord your God to the test.”** (Matthew 4:4)*

*Don't take God and His word for granted, if you don't repent and continuo to do that, then **your very bed will be snatched from under you.***

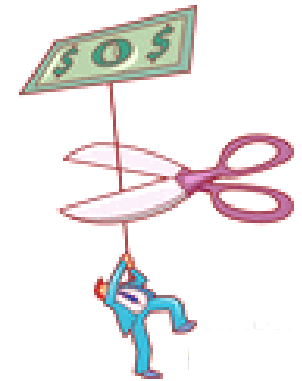
