

“¹⁵ Do not lie in wait like an outlaw against a righteous man’s house, do not raid his dwelling place; ¹⁶ for though a righteous man falls seven times, he rises again, but the wicked are brought down by calamity.”

(Proverbs 24:15-16)

The Value of living a righteous life unto the LORD is to secure God’s presence and God’s protection over your life.

They are well shielded, even if the evildoers will come and try to raid on their dwelling they will fail and put to shame because God is

watching over the home of the righteous man.

For though a righteous man falls seven times, he rises again: *He may face trials and hardship, he even may fall up to seven times but he will rise again because God is with him and will uphold him and lift him up.*

But the wicked are brought down by calamity: *Because God’s eyes against those who do evil to cut them from the land. He will watch over them to fall down and to be brought into calamity because they are unwilling to repent and follow the Lord.*

Therefore there is only one option left for you: Is to live a righteous life to secure God’s presence and protection over your life as you agree to pray.
