

“³ He said to me, “You are my servant, Israel, in whom I will display my splendor.”⁴ But I said, “I have labored to no purpose; I have spent my strength in vain and for nothing. Yet what is due me is in the LORD’s hand, and my reward is with my God.”

(Isaiah 49:3-4)

God will reward you and sure for everything good you had done to Him and to His people. “Therefore, my dear brothers, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.” (1Corinthians 15:58)

Yet what is due me is in the LORD’s hand, and my reward is with my God: Big amen for that. This is the right mind that God wanted you to have because you are working with Him and He will neither leave you nor forsake you.
