And why the blind man will not ask help from others? Pride and non willingness to humble down is the reason behind that.

Jesus was speaking about the Pharisees and he was calling them blind, because they were considering eating food without hand washing is non holiness. They were really spiritually blind to say that and to believe in such way.

But they were not willing to be corrected, and were trying to stress their point and force others and the disciples of Jesus to follow such view of things.

Jesus said to His disciples: Leave them; they are blind guides. Such kind of people with all the pride they carry they are insisting on their own ways, there is no point to answer them and advice them with God's ways because they are unwilling to humble down and accept God's truth.

Leave them; they are blind guides: Don't follow such kind of people, you will be spiritually blinded and will miss the way and the truth and the life.
