(1chronicles 19:10-12)

- 4- Let us fight bravely for the cities of our God: As we endeavour in the battle against the enemy with the Lord the churches of God will be blessed and relieved and live in peace.

The LORD will do what is good in his sight: Yes Lord we trust you that you will do your best to help us and to support us.


My Prayer
