"He brought me out into a spacious place; he rescued me because he delighted in me."

(2Samuel 22:20)

David spoke clearly about the goodness of the LORD in his life. The LORD had delivered him from all his enemies and steadily had protected him, provided well for him and brought him to a spacious place

The word that David said about the LORD, 'He rescued me because he delighted in me.' David did not say that God delighted in him because David was good, 'No', it is because God is good.

But what David meant with that statement, 'He rescued me because he delighted in me,' and what this statement means for us today?

- 1- God's forgiveness: David was sure that he was forgiven as he turned away from evil and repented from all his sins. David did sin against the LORD but he repented fully. As you turn away from doing sin and repent be assure that God had forgiven you. God rescued you because you had repented.
- **2-** God's will and plan: David was rescued and protected by the LORD because he was delighted to do God's will. In everything David did he inquired of the LORD and asked Him advice and direction. David did not do

anything in his own way; he was truly seeking to do God's will and plan.

3- "And find out what pleases the Lord." (Ephesians 5:10) David endeavoured to find out what pleased the LORD and that is why God delighted in him as He rescued him, protected him and delivered him from all his enemies.

The confidence of David on God was based on God who is good and was based on David who delighted to do everything according to God's word and ways and persevered to obey fully the plans of God for His life.

If you want to develop that confidence in the LORD and in His deliverance then be sure to do and to abide with God, His word and His will as you agree to pray.
