

“¹When the time drew near for David to die, he gave a charge to Solomon his son. ²“I am about to go the way of all the earth,” he said. “So be strong, act like a man, ³and observe what the LORD your God requires: Walk in obedience to him, and keep his decrees and commands, his laws and regulations, as written in the Law of Moses. Do this so that you may prosper in all you do and wherever you go ⁴and that the LORD may keep his promise to me: ‘If your descendants watch how they live, and if they walk faithfully before me with all their heart and soul, you will never fail to have a successor on the throne of Israel.’”

David instruct his son Solomon to do the following:

- 1- observe what the LORD your God requires.*
- 2- Walk in obedience to Him.*
- 3- Keep His decrees and commands, His laws and regulations.*

So he can receive the following from the Lord:

A- That you may prosper in all you do and wherever you go.

B- That the LORD may keep his promise to me: The condition of God was that if David’s descendant

would do all the above points as He said, ‘If your descendants watch how they live, and if they walk faithfully before me with all their heart and soul, you will never fail to have a successor on the throne of Israel,’ then there will be always a righteous man who will sit in the throne of David. And in this the mercy, justice and the righteousness of God will continue to flow in the life of the people of the Kingdom.

How about us today, how we can apply the above Scripture in our lives and receive God’s blessings and His good promises? We need to live honestly according to God’s word and commands in the bible and we need to teach them to our children and discipline them and train them to do the same, then we will reap prosperity and good and secure future for us and for our children after us.
