Psalm 20: 1-9 has an encouraging message and good teaching to us to follow:

¹ May the LORD answer you when you are in distress; may the name of the God of Jacob protect you. Amen LORD, answer my prayer when I call you in my distress and emergencies.

² May he send you help from the sanctuary and grant you support from Zion. Yes LORD I need your help, send it to me quickly through your church and through your people who are around me.

³May he remember all your sacrifices and accept your burnt offerings. Yes LORD remembers me not because I was good but because you were good and you had helped to do something good to you. Accept my prayer and my offerings.

⁴May he give you the desire of your heart and make all your plans succeed. LORD I will continue to delight in you, trusting that I will receive from you and soon the desire of my heart.

⁵ May we shout for joy over your victory and lift up our banners in the name of our God. May the LORD grant all your requests. Amen dear LORD, let many hear the good things and the victory that

you will grant to me and rejoice with your kindness and faithfulness to me.

⁶Now this I know: The LORD gives victory to his anointed. He answers him from his heavenly sanctuary with the victorious power of his right hand. Dear LORD your word and your promises that you sent to me in this Psalm had increased my faith and trust in you.

⁷Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God. I will always put my full trust on you and not be enticed to trust the things of the world.

8 They are brought to their knees and fall, but we rise up and stand firm. Yes dear LORD, your word and promises are sure, and impart to us all, we your people, a great victory over all our enemies that around us.

⁹LORD, give victory to the king! Answer us when we call!

My Prayer: Yes LORD answers us when we call and give us victory. Not only to us but also victory to every one of your people who is in trouble wherever they are, this is our prayer and thanksgiving to you in Jesus name Amen.
