

“The blessing of the Lord brings wealth, and He adds no trouble to it.”

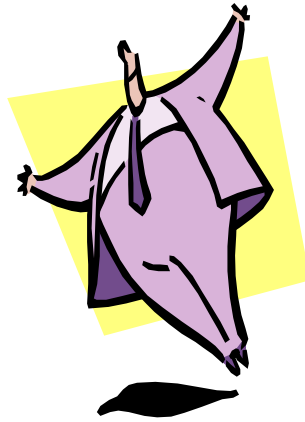
(Proverbs 10: 22)

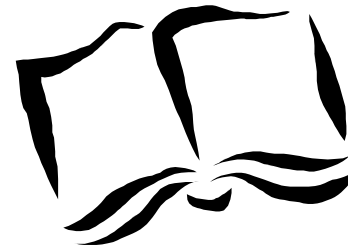
