The blind man his problem was blindness and this problem is

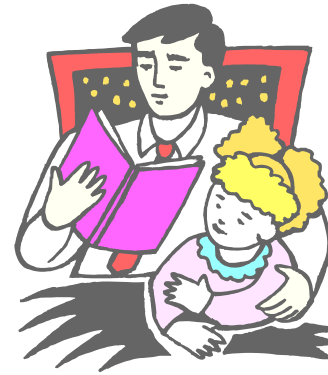
impossible to be solved even to this day, but with Jesus it was possible to be handled and the blind man got relief of a chronic and long term disability.
