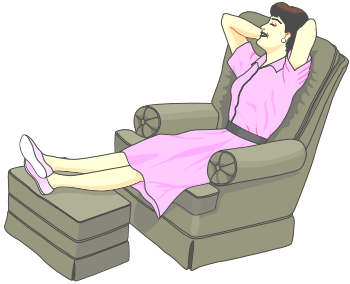


**“He settles the barren woman in her home as a happy mother of children. Praise the Lord.”**

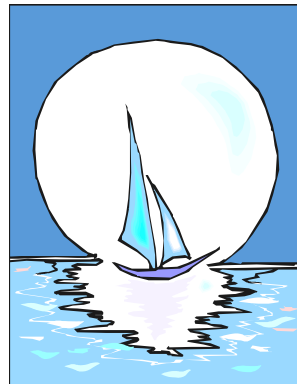
In the same way God can deal with any situation that we pass through in a

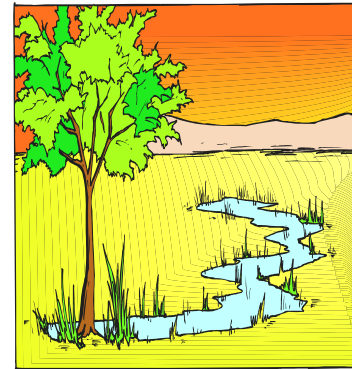
Do not be worry if you are passing a turmoil God can manage it; He will settle the matter and restore everything back and bring the calmness once again into your life

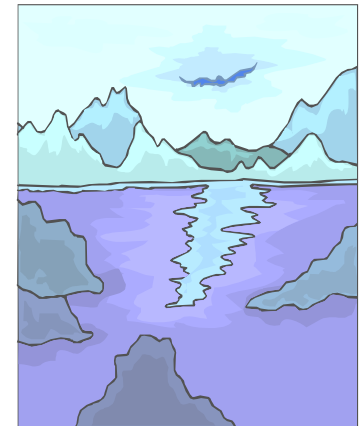
