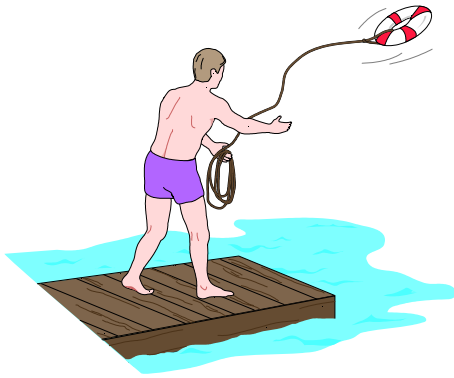


***“My comfort in my suffering is this:

(Psalm 119:50)***



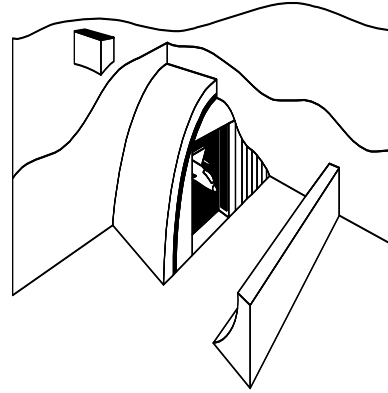

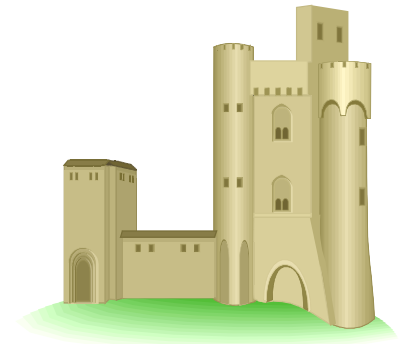
