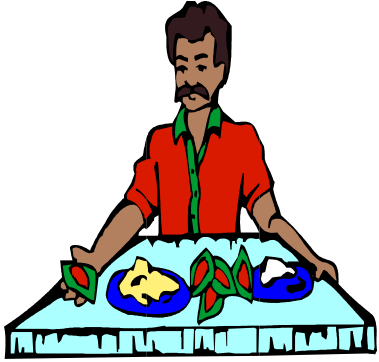

You noticed in this world and in the life of the people around that all they wake up early in the morning and they move diligently with great endeavor seeking their own good.

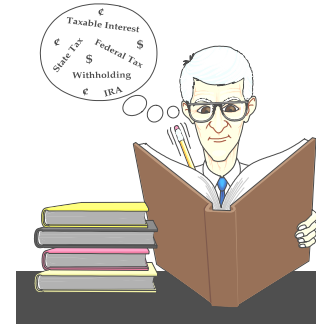
It is true everyone is responsible for himself, no one should suppose to do what you ought to perform.
