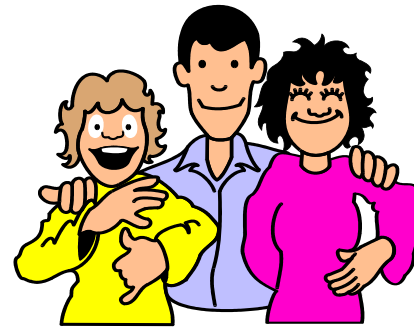

My Prayer

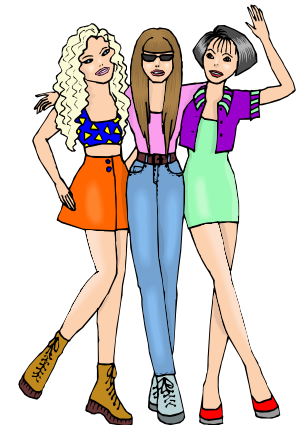
