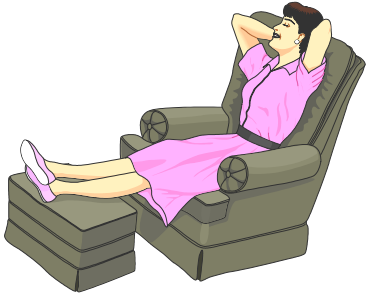


“A servant cannot be corrected by mere words; though he understand, he will not respond.”
