(Proverbs 29: 7)



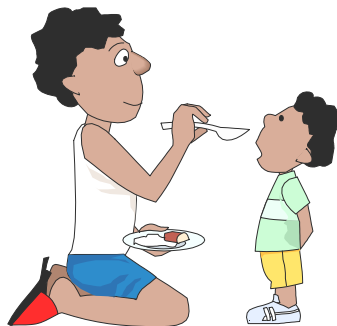
The righteous man is the one who follow God in his life. He is a person who cultivates and develops the characters of God in his personality.

The righteous man would have these good characters of God in him. He is a man of concern. He will not look only to his own interest, but as well as the interests of others.

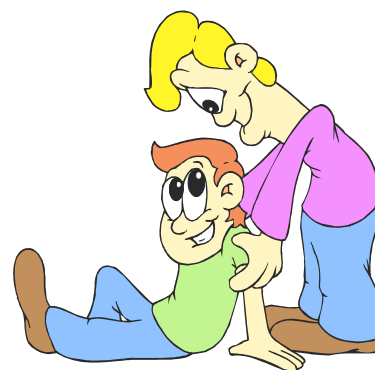
The righteous man has a concern to bring justice to others. He is a man who, “Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute.”
