In this verse Jesus compared Himself with the prophets; those who proclaim God's will to the people. The Old Testament prophets suffered because people would not accept to

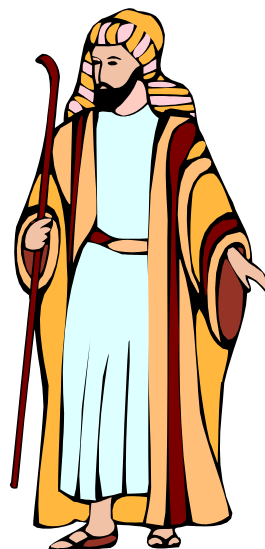
change their minds and follow what God had decreed to them to follow.
