Such a man will have the following:

- A- Who will dwell on the heights: He has Eternity and lives with God forever. B- Whose refuge will be the mountain fortress: He will always have God's guidance and God's protection over His life.
- C- His bread will be supplied, and water will not fail him: He will always have God's provision and God's good supply throughout his life, to him and to his household.

God's Word promotes us and encourages us to obey God more and walk in His ways. These are the true promises of Him who love us and wants us to follow His step and Word in our lives as we agree to pray.
