You may hear in many occasions these accusations against God; ‘Why God is silent? Why God is not doing any thing?’ ‘If God is there why then there is injustice?’ ‘Why God is allowing crimes, wars, explosion, floods?’ ‘Why He is indifference to all the injustice that is widespread all around?’

You may hear people speaking against God this way: ‘Why God is against me?’ ‘Why God is doing badly to me?’ ‘Why God is not helping me?’ A lot of that you may hear today, and God is also hearing the same.

God today is defending Himself from these accusations. God is not indifference to all the wrong things that is going on from wars to floods or to typhoons or earthquakes or injustice or famine. God had already spoken to the people before all that had happened.

God is telling today, **“But I gave them this command.”** God had already spoke to them and had warned them, but it seems that the same people they turn their back against God and throw at their backs His Word to them.

God had told the people clearly: **“Obey me, and I will be your God and you will be my people.”** God had asked them obedience and to walk in His ways, so in the days where troubles are happening they will find refuge under His wings.

God had said clearly, **“Walk in all the ways I command you, that it may go well with you.”** He told the people to walk in the ways that He had commanded so that things will go well with the people. But it seems they did not take the word of God and His warning seriously, so disasters and mishaps had come to their lives.

To the naïve the question is ‘Where is God?’ But to the prudent, ‘God is watching to see that His Word is fulfilled.’

Therefore, let us today repent as long as it is called today before disaster would come. Don’t wait for troubles, be earnest and repent.
