

“Then the LORD said to me: “Even if Moses and Samuel were to stand before me, my heart would not go out to this people. Send them away from my presence! Let them go!”

(Jeremiah 15:1)



Oh Lord, why like that, what had happened Lord, what was wrong with the people, Lord what they had done wrong?

“This is what the LORD says about this people: “They greatly love to wander; they do not restrain their feet. So the LORD does not accept them; he will now remember their wickedness and punish them for their sins.” (Jeremiah 14:10) Yes, and true, they made the Lord tired. God was calling them and searching for them, wanting them to come back to Him. But the more He was calling, the more they have gone far away. Therefore, “When I called, they did not listen; so when they called, I would not listen,” says the LORD Almighty.” (Zechariah 7:13)

What Moses said to the Lord in his intercession for the peoples’ sins? **“But now, please forgive their sin—but if not, then blot me out of the book you have written.” (Exodus 32:32)** Moses was greatly involved in his intercession for the people and put his life even in danger for

them. And God accepted the prayer and the intercession of Moses and He forgave them.

What Samuel did in his intercession for the peoples’ sins? **“As for me, far be it from me that I should sin against the LORD by failing to pray for you. And I will teach you the way that is good and right.” (1 Samuel 12:23)** God was listening for Samuel prayers in behalf of the people.

But what we found here that even if Moses and Samuel would intercede for the peoples’ sins God will not listen!

There is a time that God’s heart would not go out for the people because they had abused His grace; they took God for granted and ignored God’s call for them to repent. Therefore be careful, don’t test the patience of God and force Him to be cruel with you. Be earnest and repent.
