The Lord Jesus Christ had promised us the following: **“I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. ¹³But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. But always there is the good news: **“The wickedness of the wicked man will not cause him to fall when he turns from it.”** What the Word of God telling us here that if we are doing wrong we will be allowed to live with God and forever if we repent from our wrong doings. That is God’s offer and His love and faithfulness toward us; that if we repent and turn away from our wickedness then there is hope for us, the salvation of God.
