God also promised this: **“I will increase the number of”** The Lord here is promising not only the quality of life become better but even in quantity there will be increase in number.

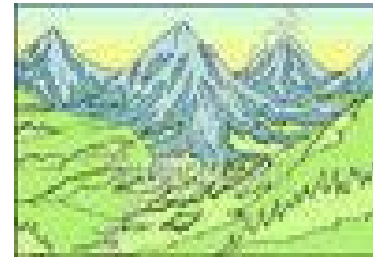
