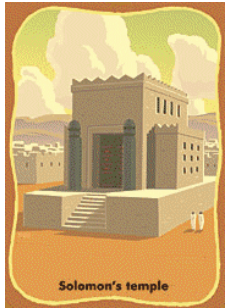


“Son of man, describe the temple to the people of Israel, that they may be ashamed of their sins. Let them consider its perfection, and if they are ashamed of all they have done, make known to them the design of the temple—its arrangement, its exits and entrances—its whole design and all its regulations and laws. Write these down before them so that they may be faithful to its design and follow all its regulations.”

(Ezekiel 43:10-11)



That they may be ashamed of their sins: The Lord at certain times use another way to bring the people to repentance; by making them ashamed of their sins. Certain times when God is showing to them that He knows about their sins and their shortcoming, but He still loving them and forgiving them all wrongdoing, and giving them another chance to repent. That may plant in people hearts the feeling of shamefulness and bring them to repentance, recognizing that God's grace was abundant in their lives and being. Although they are unfaithful but God is still faithful to them and wants to help them and bless them.

God is sending the prophet Ezekiel to describe to the Israelites the temple that He desired. God at that time of Israel history where the temple in Jerusalem was destroyed and people are longing to go back, He instructed Ezekiel to describe to the people **the design of the temple—its**

arrangement, its exits and entrances—its whole design and all its regulations and laws. Restoring the temple back to its magnificent size and arrangement it means to restore the blessing of God to His people and to restore their identity, splendor and glory. As they will come to know that then that provision of God will make them ashamed of their sins and bring them to repentance.

Let them consider its perfection: The perfection of the temple is the perfection of God's plan in their lives and His full blessing to them.

The message is for you and is the same. Do you know the great plan of God for you and how much is waiting for you from God's blessing when you repent and willing to walk in His ways? Do you know how much you are losing as you continue to move in your own way and in the wrong direction that God had asked you to move? The message is written for you so that you would be faithful to God's command and follow His regulation. As you obey and persevere in following them you will be fully blessed with the Lord and with His great plan for your life.
