Like in a market work they know what is original and what is faked. The same for the work of God the people must know how to distinguish between the clean that God desires, and what is unclean that God hates.

These are all the responsibility of those who lead and teach the people of God how to live their lives for God. This will have two valuable impacts.

- 1- *The picture of God to the world will be clear.*
- 2- *The truth will pass correctly and precisely to the next generation.*
